## Water Department Report – June 2026 Regular Meeting

- Monthly coliform compliance sampling was completed with no issues.
- Work continued on the risk and resilience assessment, which is due to the EPA by June 30, 2026. Updates to our emergency response plan are due by December 31, 2026
- Water service to an abandoned home on Prescott Lane was terminated.
- We attended the Vermont Rural Water Association annual conference at Lake Morey on May 13 & 14.
- The siding in the area for the new door to the office was tested for asbestos.
- Participated in another Community Visit meeting hosted by the Vermont Council on Rural Development.
- The state has reviewed the Step 2 engineering agreement and has asked for some minor changes.
- Monthly regulatory compliance was completed with no issues.
- We have applied for a leak detection grant through the drinking water program.
- Valve exercising and hydrant maintenance work was completed.
